Computer Networks & Security

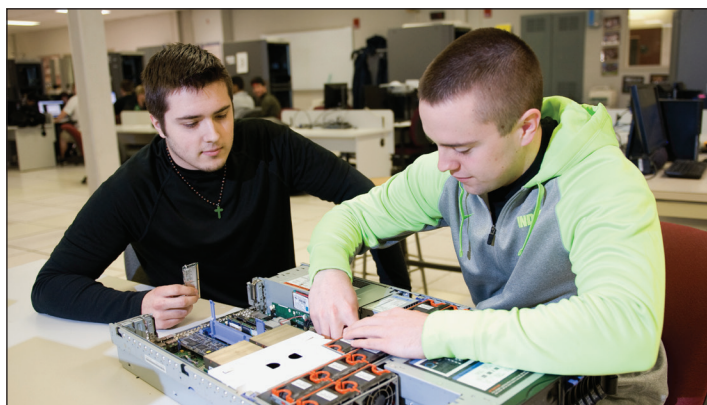
