At the discretion of the ISO Advisor(s), your scholarship can be revoked for being non-active and/or for not enrolling as a full-time student for a given term. **This is a one-year scholarship and you must reapply each year.** Scholarship amounts range from \$600-\$1,200. Please note that you cannot receive both a Foundation Scholarship and a Club Scholarship for the academic year. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be processed.

By applying for the ISO Scholarship for the 2018-2019 academic year, I agree that I will actively participate in a minimum of the following events if I receive a scholarship:

- Minimum of six of the nine monthly ISO meetings (September – May)
- International Education Week Country Showcase and other events
- International Dinner Fundraiser
- International Festival at Ottumwa Mall

- IHCC Pay It Forward Week club events
- In addition, at least two community events and at least one additional on-campus event
