If URL hyperlinks on you, right click on the URL, click "remove hyperlink" Add the period at the end of the URL and then go back and put in the angle brackets—make sure the period is already at the end of the URL before you add the > at the end. Then use the back ARROW and insert the end angle bracket (>) between the end of the URL and the period.
