GENERAL ELIGIBILITY
Requirements

To get and keep aid from almost all Student Financial Aid Programs, you must:

- * Submit a completed FAFSA
 - * Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen
 - * Have a valid Social Security Number
 - * Have a valid High School diploma, GED, or meet the requirements for home-schooling
 - * Be working toward a degree, diploma or certificate (that's recognized by the Department of Education & the State of Iowa as an eligible program for aid)
 - * For males, be registered with Selective Service (if required)
 - * Make "Satisfactory Academic Progress" (SAP). (See the SAP policy online at: www.indianhills.edu/finaid)
 - * Not owe a refund on a Federal Grant
 - * Not be in default on a Federal Student Loan
- **** For loans, be enrolled at least half-time each term (4 credit hours is considered half-time each term)
- **** Pell Grant eligibility is determined by enrollment status.
If you enrolled less than full time, Pell Grant will be reduced accordingly.
