- IHCC uses the student's initial COMPASS test scores for placement into Math and English courses. Please review Reading, Writing, and Math subject areas prior to testing.

- If you are taking a COMPASS test for admission to another school, or applying for para-professional certification, a fee of \$15 for COMPASS testing will be charged.
- Prospective health occupation students may retake the COMPASS test to gain entry into their program of choice. A \$15 fee will incur after the second attempt.
