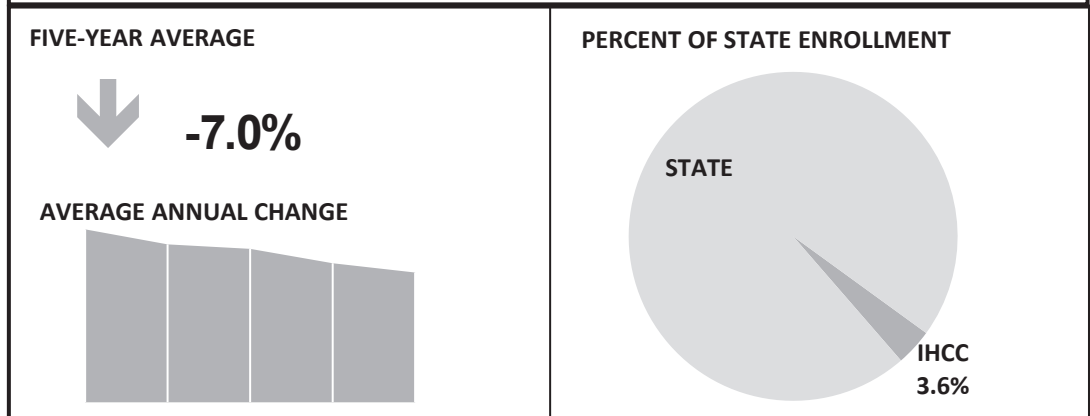

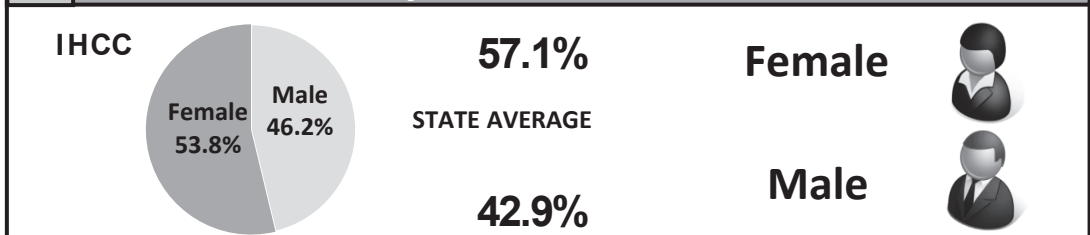

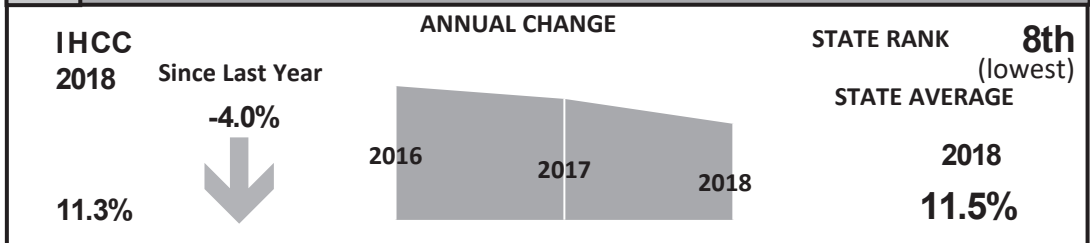

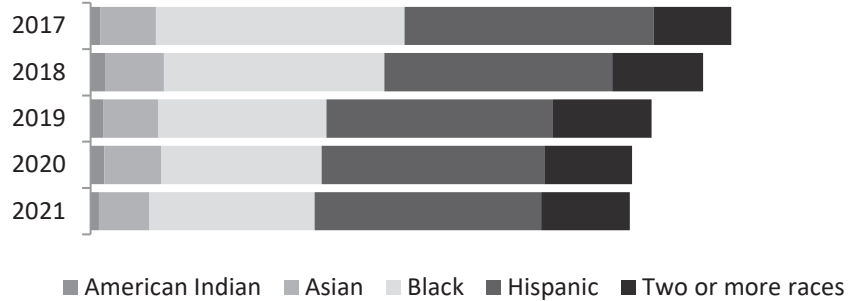

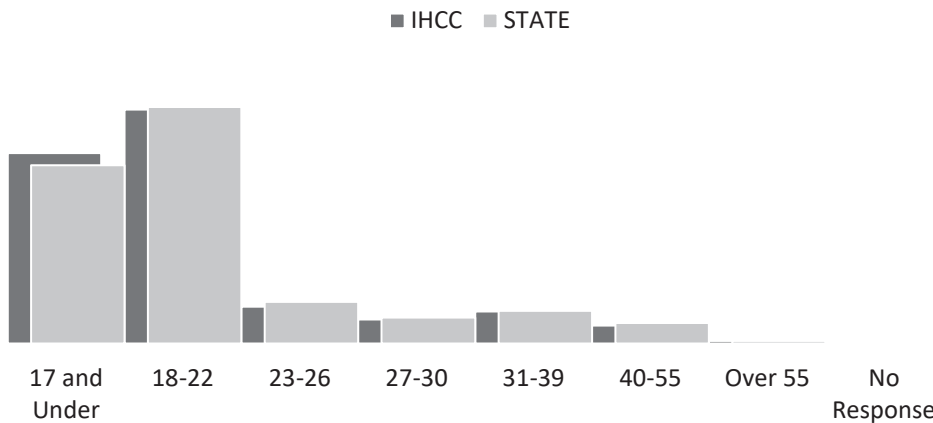

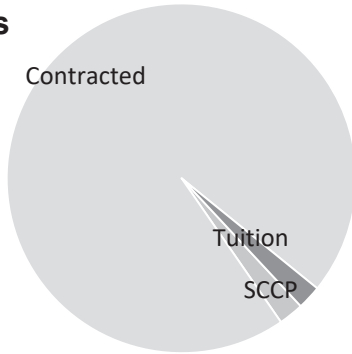

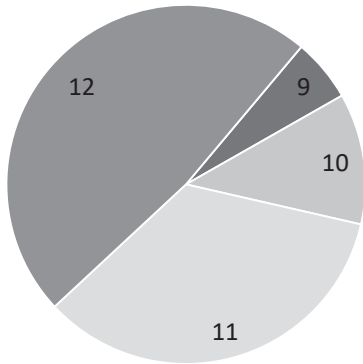

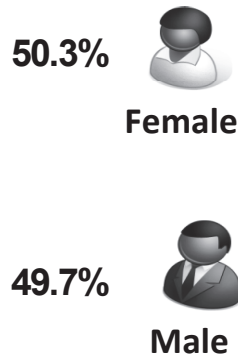
Latest Five-Years Percentage of Students Jointly Enrolled



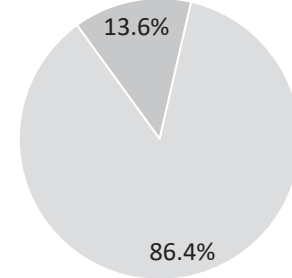

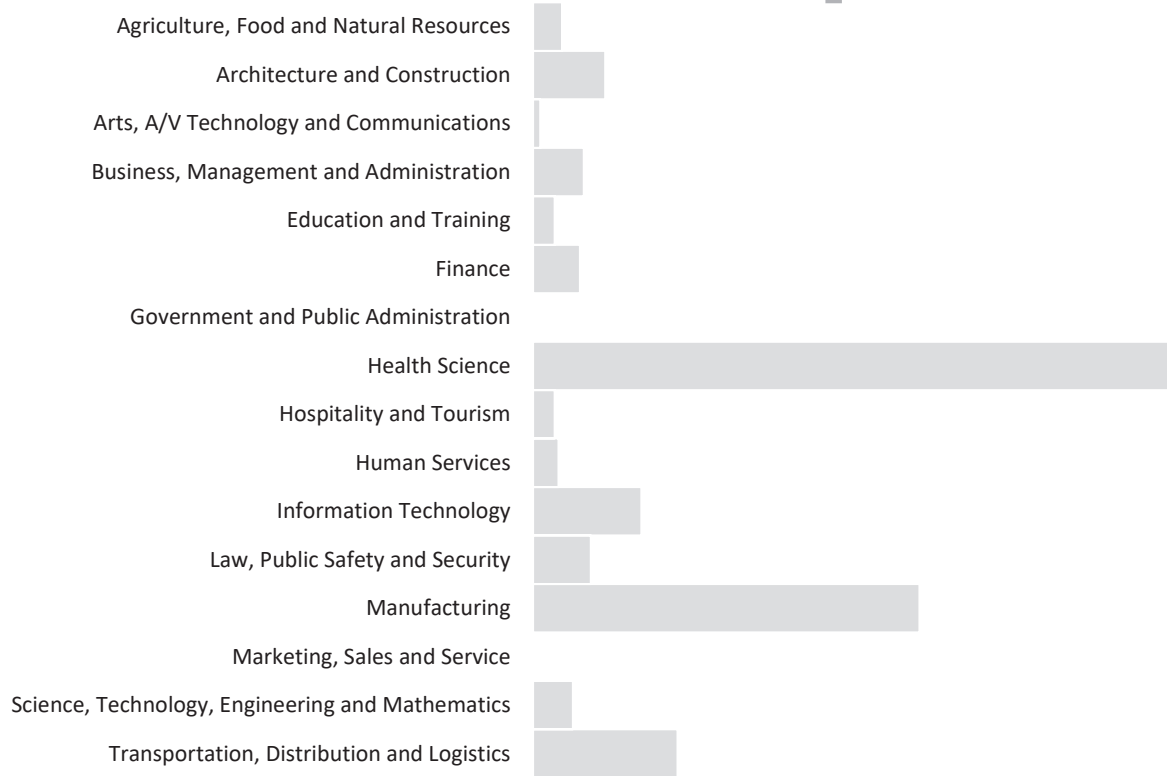

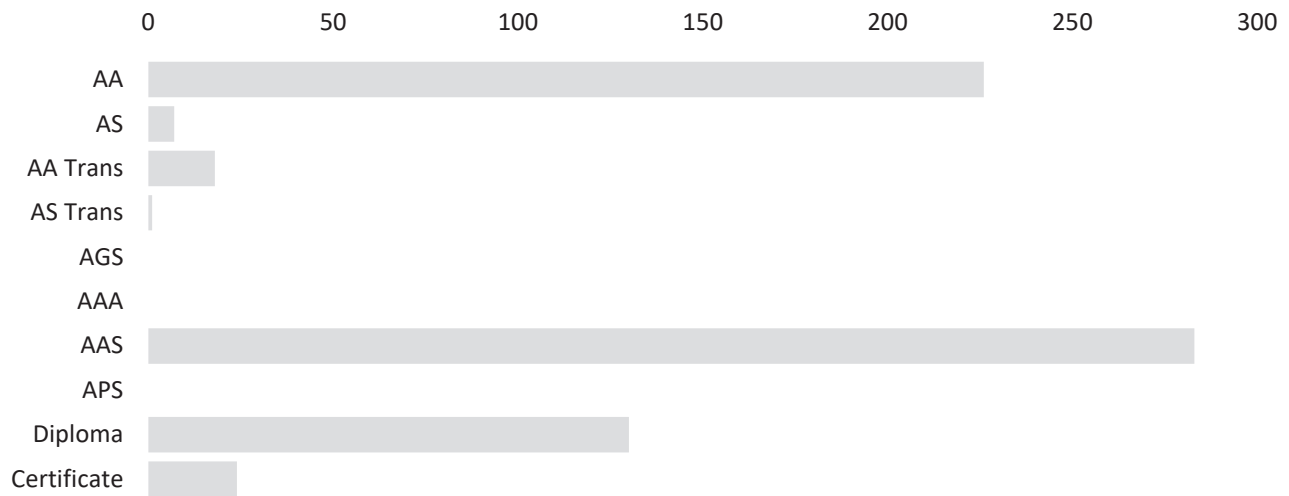

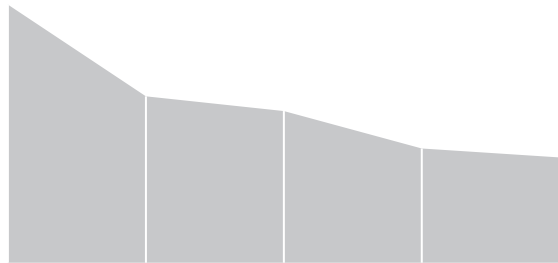

Five-Year Average Annual Change



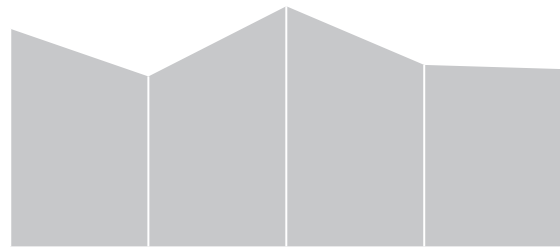
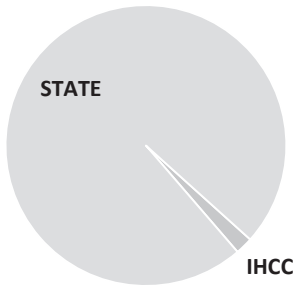

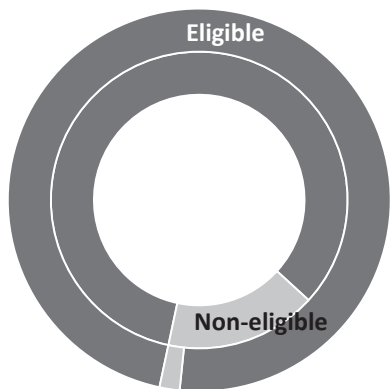

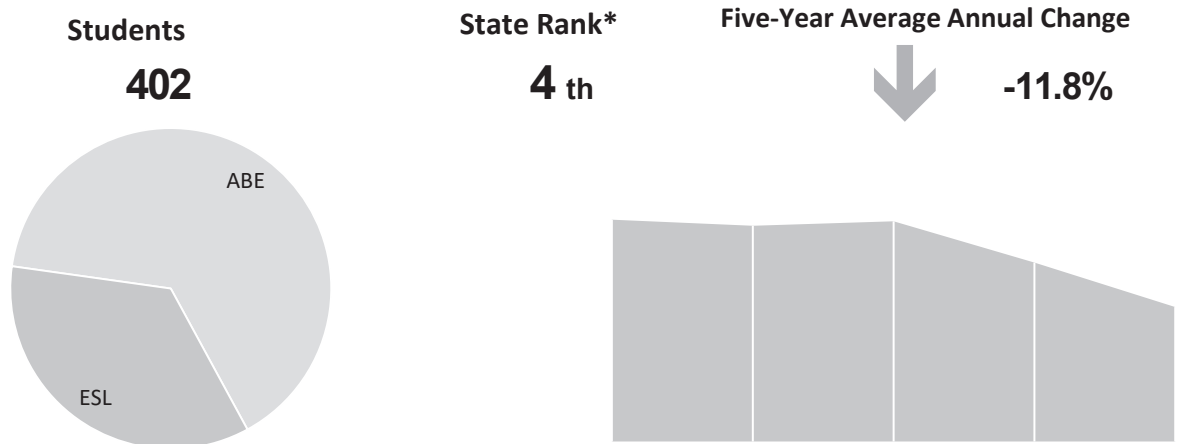

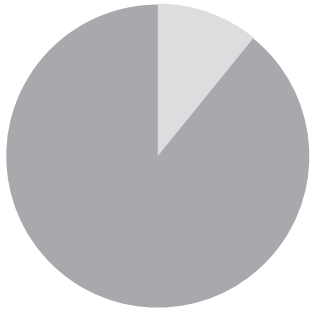

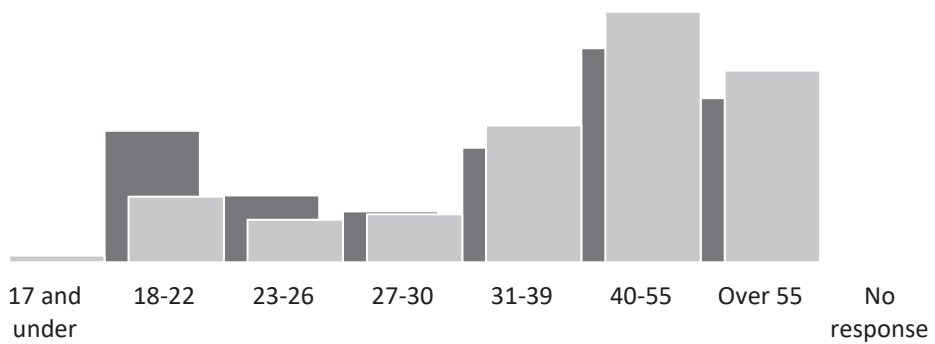
