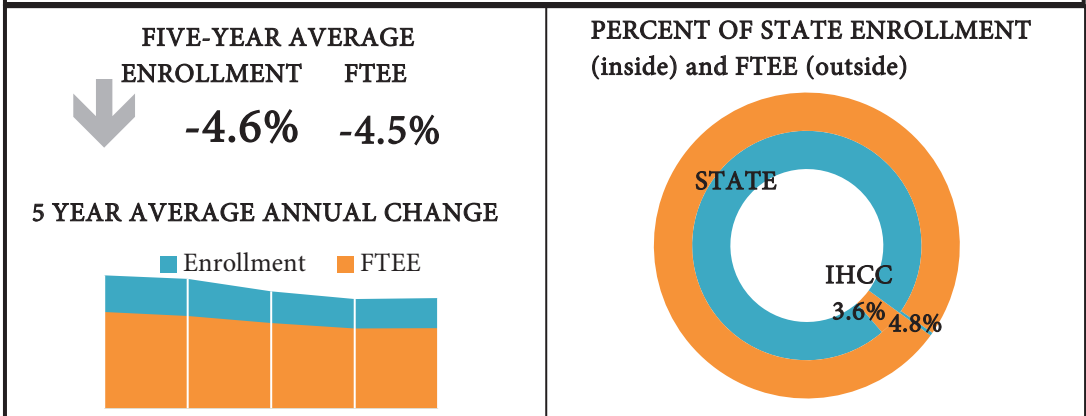

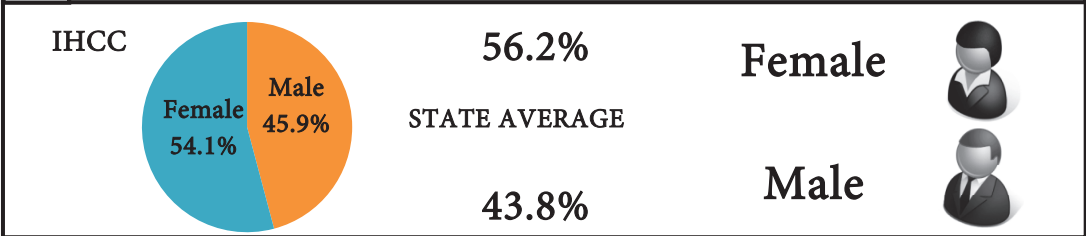

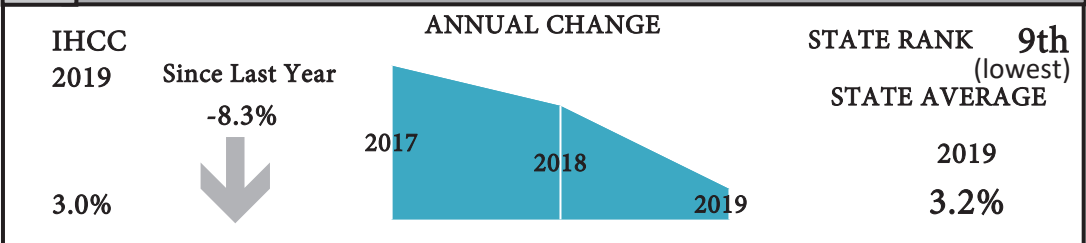

3 Federal Loans Default Rates



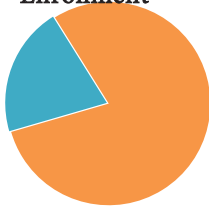
4 Enrollment by Racial and Ethnic Background

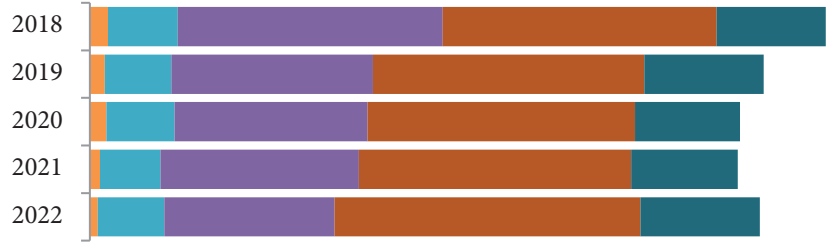

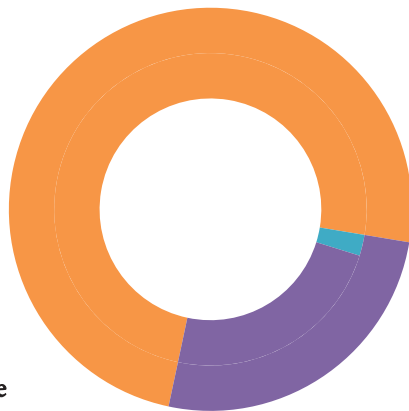

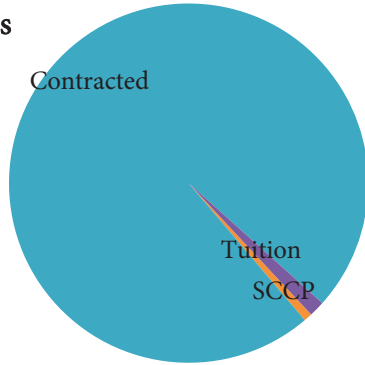

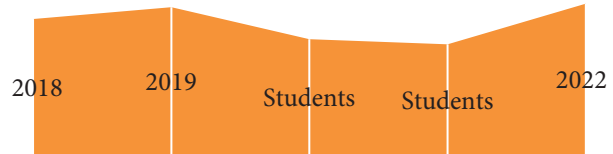

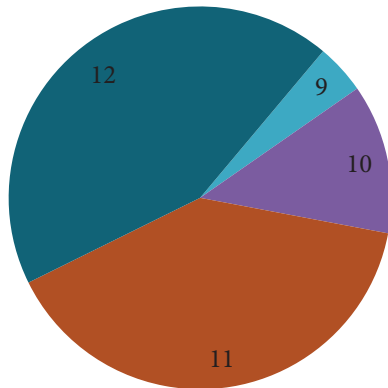

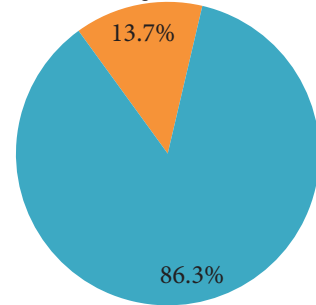

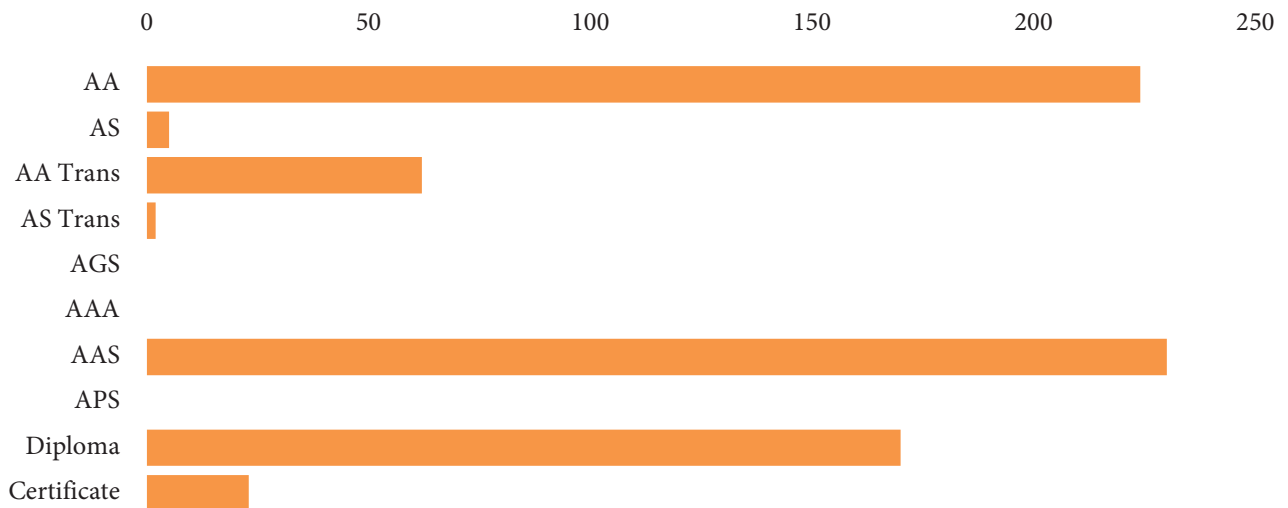
Five -Year Average Annual Change

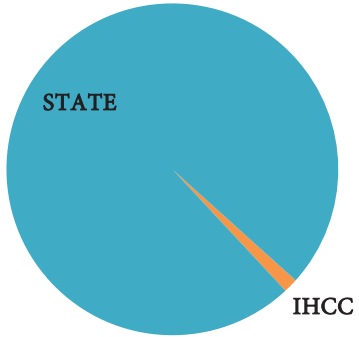

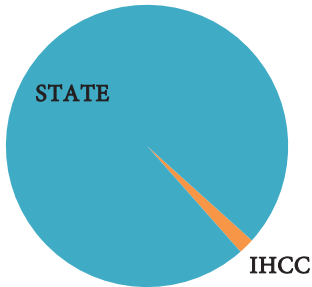

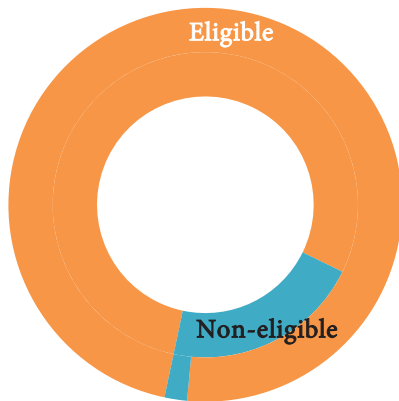

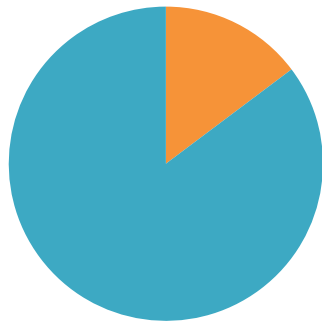

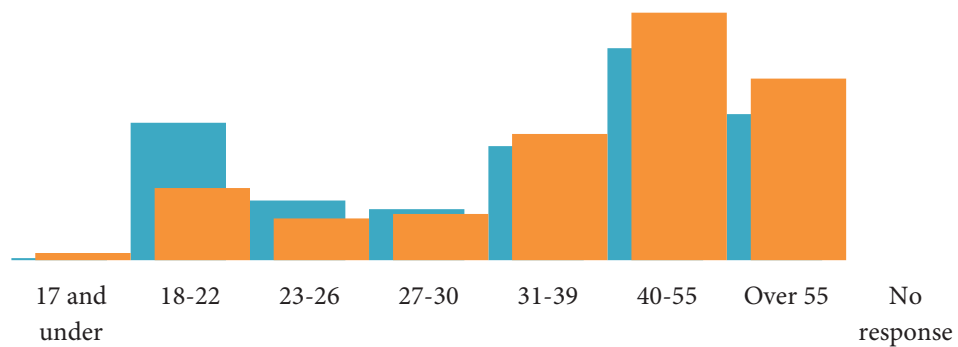

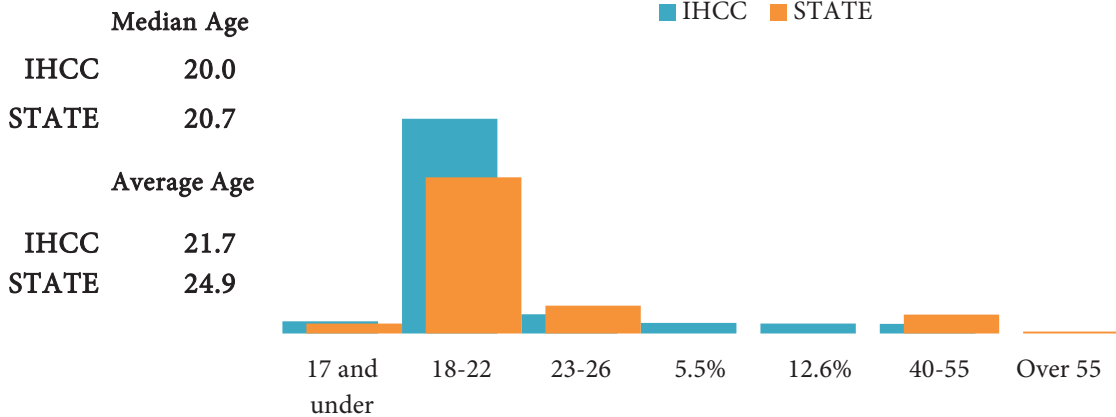
