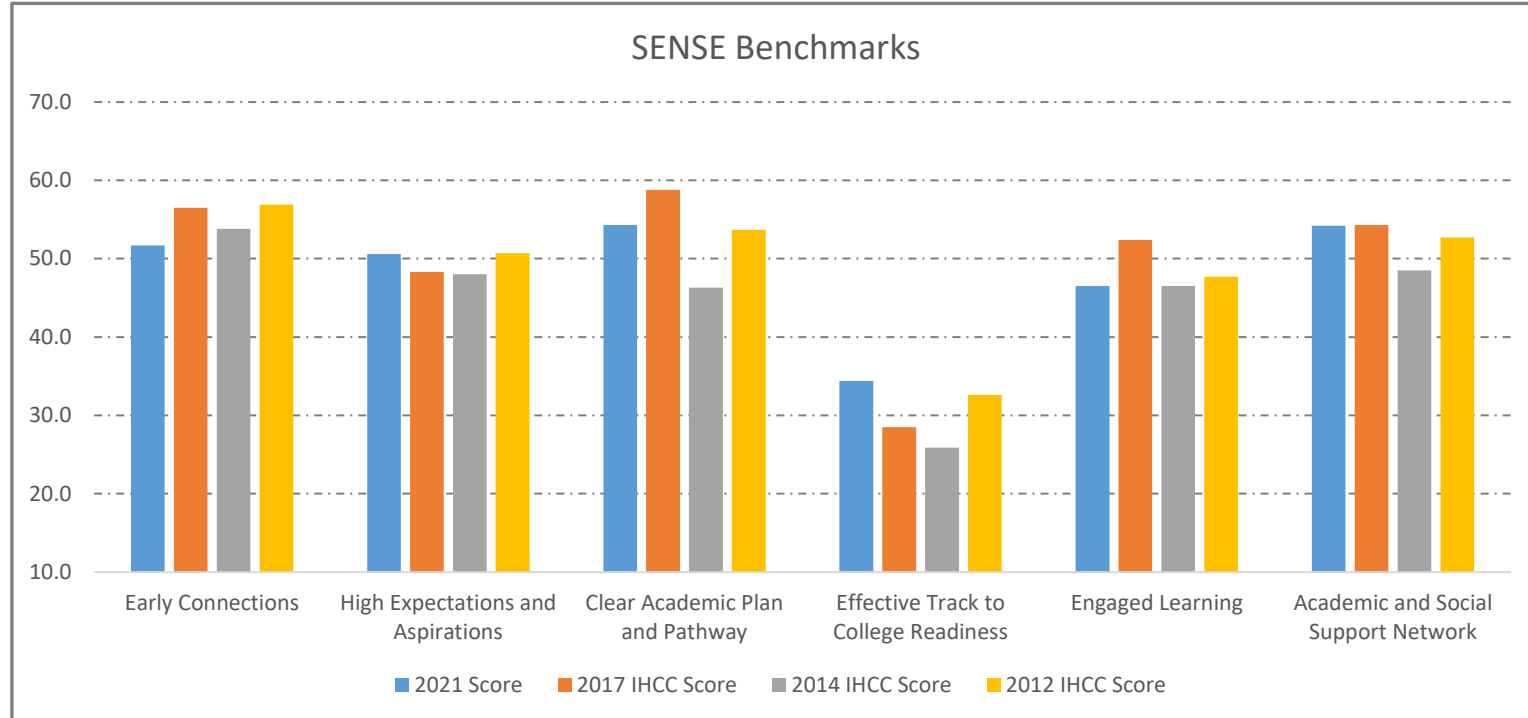


## SENSE & CCSSE Survey Results

Indian Hills Community College has participated in the Community College Survey of Student Engagement since 2011. This survey is conducted in the spring of the year, following the fall administration of its sister survey, SENSE (Survey of Entering Student Engagement). We were initially on a two-year rotation, even fall terms and odd spring terms, for this process. After the 2015 survey administration, the VP for Academic Affairs and Institutional Effectiveness and the Director of Institutional Research and Assessment determined a longer interval between surveying would better accommodate our culture. Therefore, we began a three-year survey rotation. Both the SENSE and CCSSE surveys have allowed IHCC to compare progress made on different initiatives over time, focus on areas of weakness and track consistent questions, benchmarking our progress to our results, other community colleges in Iowa, and to the CCSSE cohort.

The next set of results are the benchmarks for these surveys over time and a comparison from the first administration to the most recent.
