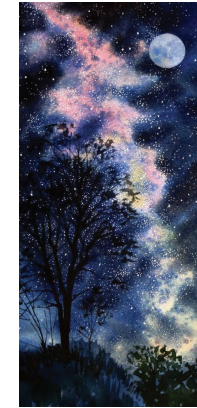

Opera Iowa: The Barber of Seville

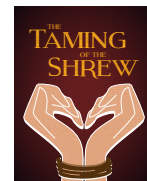

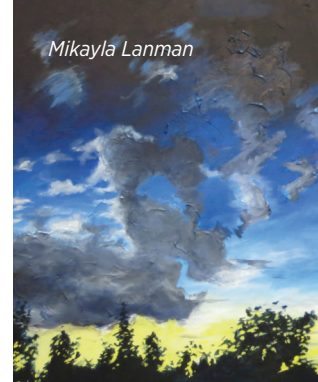
