Skilled Iowa

Skilled Iowa is Governor Brandstad's initiative to upskill Iowa's workforce. Now more than ever, American businesses need a strong, skilled workforce to overcome today's challenges. The Skilled Iowa initiative helps assess and increase the skill level in two ways.

- National Career Readiness Certification
- Skilled Iowa Internships

The National Career Readiness Certificate is issued by ACT. The NCRC provides an assessment of an employee's skills that can be accepted nationwide. Individuals are tested on Applied Math, Reading for Information, and Locating Information.

Skilled Iowa Internships allow employers to assess individuals in a work environment. Internships can last anywhere from 1 day to 3 weeks. A detailed training plan is developed with the employer.
