

ROBERT F. KENNEDY – MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

HISTORY OF THIS ORGANIZATION

The Kennedy-King Memorial Scholarship Fund is a local scholarship established following the deaths of Martin Luther King, Jr. and Robert F. Kennedy, who were committed to raising the level of education for those who could not do it for themselves. Many of the recipients have been the first in their families to attend college. Minorities are encouraged to apply.

The members of the board of these memorial scholarship funds seek to encourage qualified students in Wapello County to obtain higher education beyond the secondary school level. Since 1968, Kennedy King scholarships have been given to graduates of Wapello County high schools.

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded each year to a student who is already enrolled at Indian Hills. Applicants will be considered on the basis of scholastic performance and financial need. Decisions will be announced in the spring. Scholarship monies are raised through fund-raising projects, endowments, and local citizens.

7. One reference from a non-relative (please attach)
8. If your plans change, or there is an early drop, you agree to return the scholarship
