1. Apply for Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**)
 - a. Go to: <https://fafsa.ed.gov> to sign up! Use school code **008298 (IHCC)**
2. Apply to Indian Hills www.indianhills.edu/admissions & apply to a Job Corps sponsored program.
3. Take the **Accuplacer test** or **ACT scores** may be submitted
 - a. Take at IHCC's Trustee Hall –Testing center; (641) 683-5142 or testing@indianhills.edu

Must complete high school education prior to enrollment to IHCC & be Job Corps Eligible



Benefits from Ottumwa Job Corps Center when approved for sponsorship

- Tuition Free Education
- Financial Aid Assistance
- Assistance with books, uniforms, supplies, tools, and testing fees
- Medical insurance assistance
- Academic advising and registration each term
- Personalized and consistent educational support
- Bi weekly stipend of \$40 (the first 180 days of sponsorship) then \$70 (after 180 days until finished with the program) on rapid pay card
- \$390 per term for meal plan (4 meals per week)
- Clothing allotment for online Amazon shopping trip for interview clothing or work clothing with completion of your program
- \$500 upon completion of your program
- Career transition services 1 year after graduation

After you apply your Outreach & Admissions Counselor will need the following documents:

- Social Security Card
- State ID/Driver's License
- Birth Certificate
- IEP/504 Plan (if you have one)
- Official High Schools Record/Transcripts
- Copy of GED/Diploma
- Immunization Record
- Medical/Mental Health Records (if available)
- Insurance Card (front & back)
- Proof of Income
