If I could take any three living people with me on the first manned mission to Mars, the first person I would want to take is my boyfriend Brody. He is very good at keeping me calm and encouraging me to be more optimistic. The second person I would want to take with me is Sunita Williams. She is an astronaut and has lots of experience in space. The last person I would want to take with me is Robert Zubrin.
