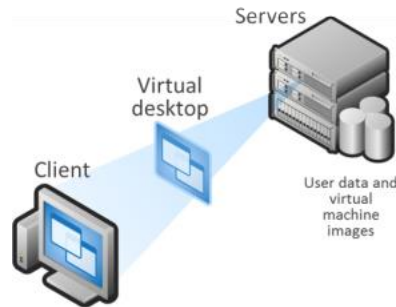


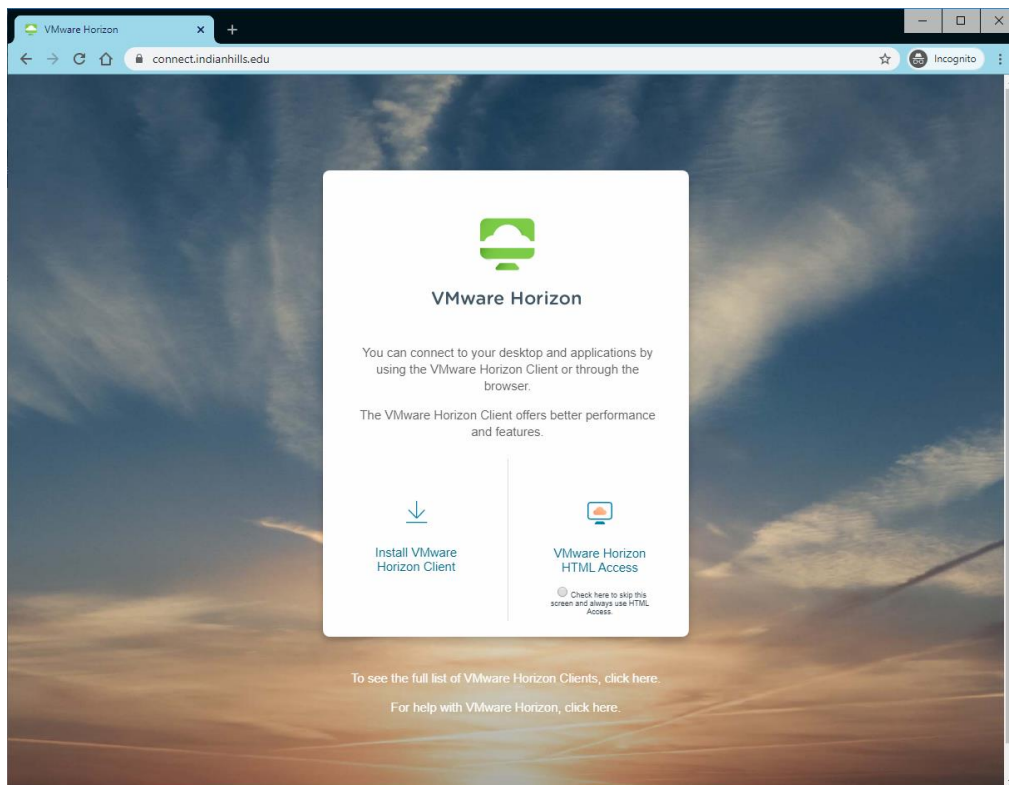
Horizon HTML Access

These instructions will guide you through connecting to a VMWare Horizon Virtual Desktop remotely using the Horizon HTML (Web) Client. A virtual desktop is a computing environment hosted on a server and delivered to a client remotely.

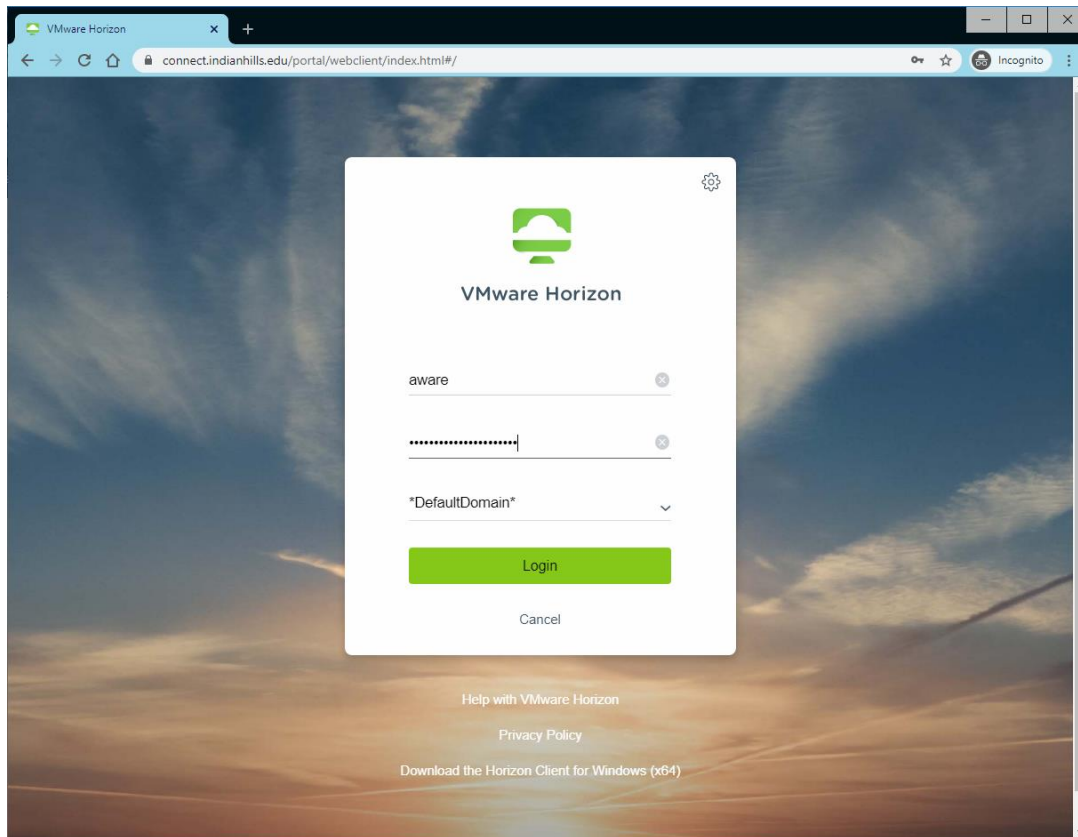


Virtual Desktops made available to you by the IT Department allow you to access a computer at the organization from any client with internet access. Because the virtual desktop is hosted on campus, you can access organization resources such as the G: drive from your virtual desktop.

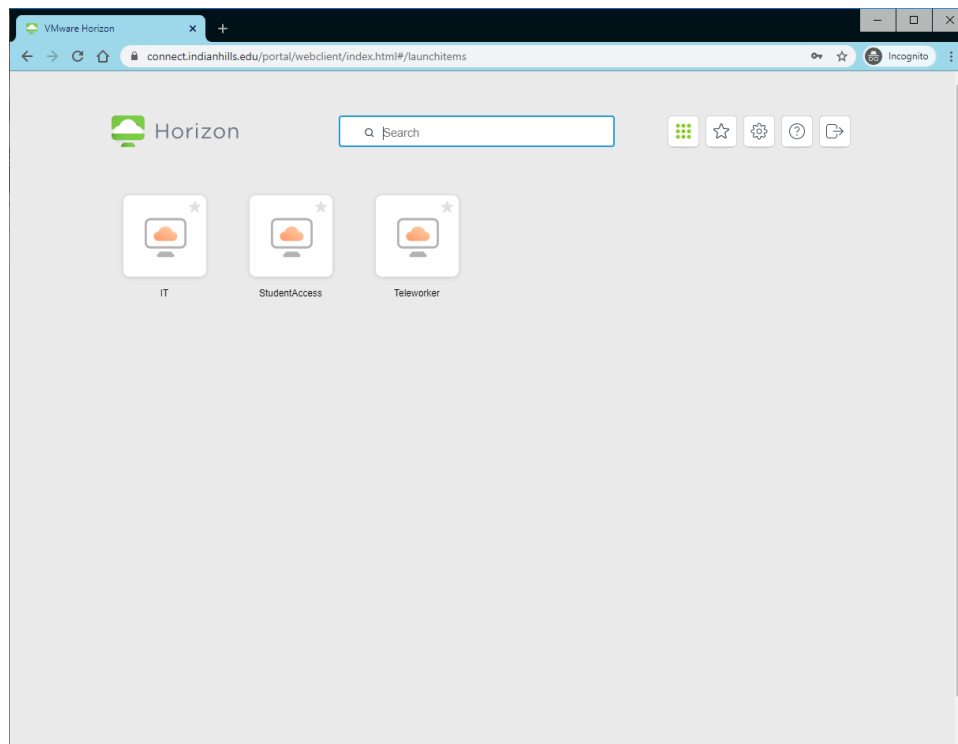
1. In a web browser (Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox) navigate to <https://connect.indianhills.edu/>
2. Select the 'VMware Horizon HTML Access' option



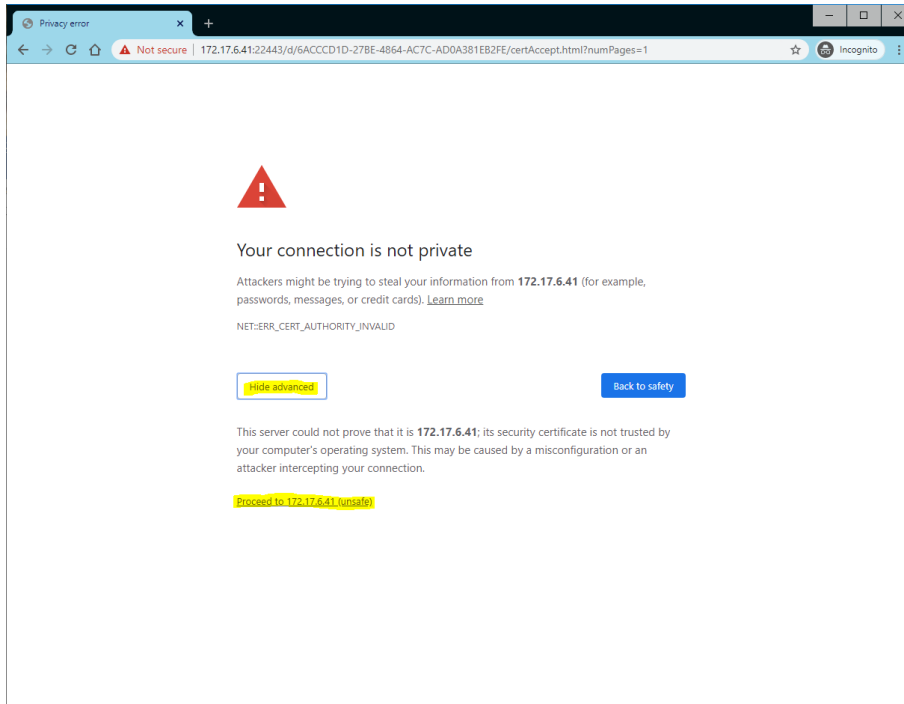
3. Log on using your *network credentials* (i.e. the same username and password you use to log into your work computer)



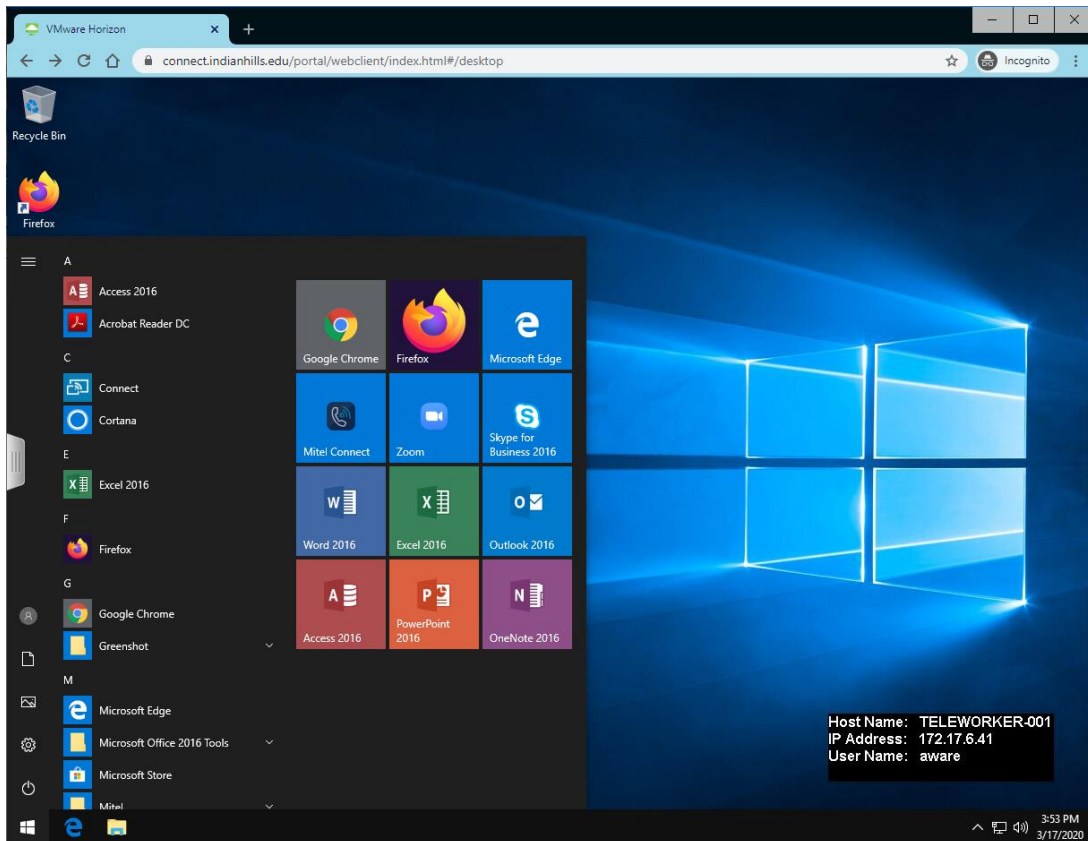
4. After logging in, you will be presented with a list of virtual desktops you can use. Select the 'Teleworker' desktop



- a. Some users may be presented with a certificate warning, like this one. If you see a certificate warning select 'advanced' and click 'proceed'



5. You will be connected to your virtual desktop



- When you're ready to disconnect from your virtual desktop, click the tab on the left hand side of the screen to expand the toolbar. From the toolbar, click the options button in the top right and select 'Log out'
