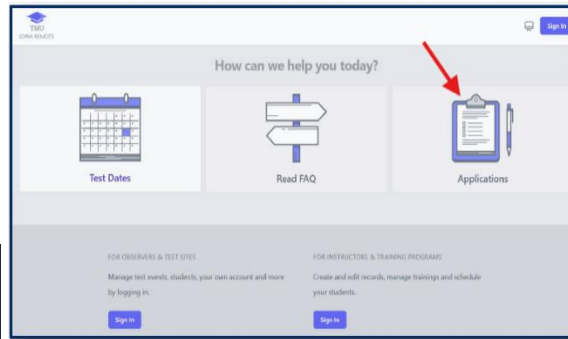


# CNA Written Exam (TMU)

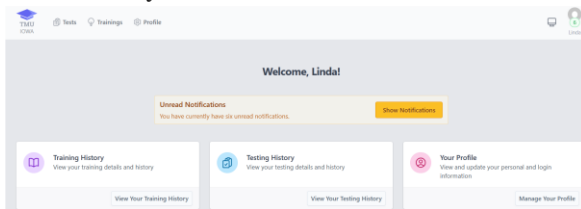
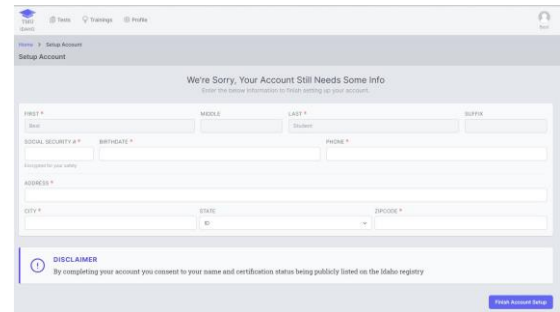


## To schedule:

1. Go to <https://ia.tmutest.com/> and click Applications
2. Complete Nurse Aide Testing Request Application at <https://ia.tmutest.com/apply/9>

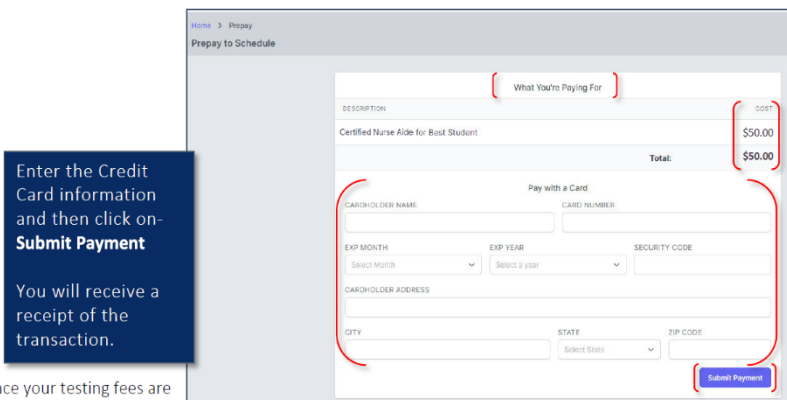
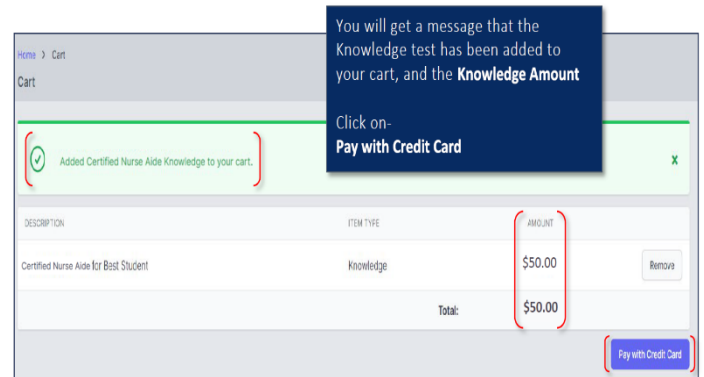
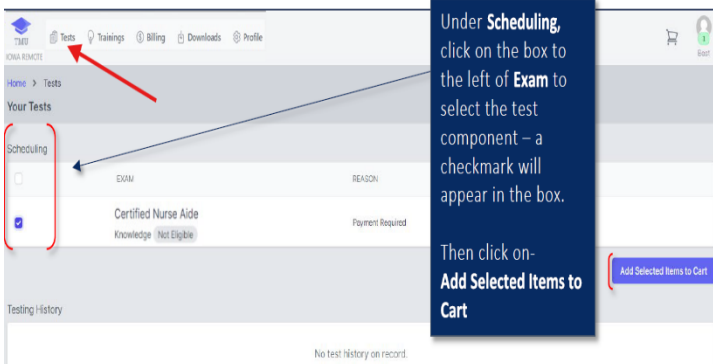


3. Enter all the information needed to complete your account. (You will need your SS#)
4. You will get a message your account has been completed. Write down your username and password. You MUST bring it on test day!



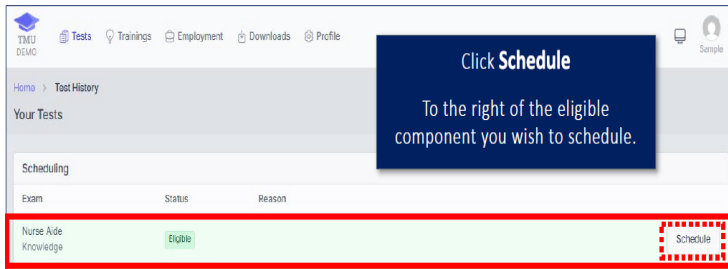
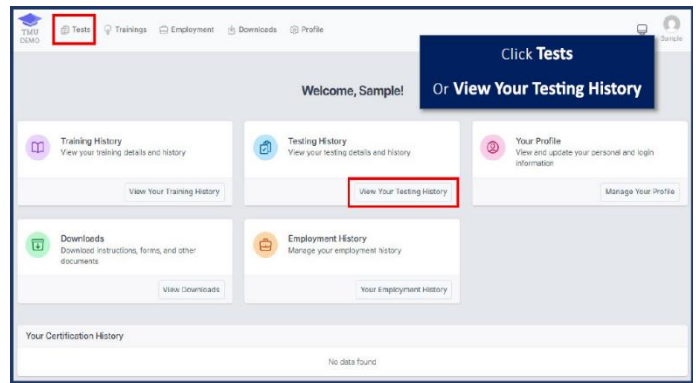
5. Testing fees must be paid before you can schedule a test date. Once your Nurse Aide Testing Request Application has been approved, you will receive an email and text message that you are eligible to schedule a test date. If your employer or a program is paying for your test they must complete a Facility Account Information Application at <https://ia.tmutest.com/apply/4/>
6. Pay for test: Click on Tests to get started.

Securely processed Visa or MasterCard credit/debit card information is required when paying testing fees online.

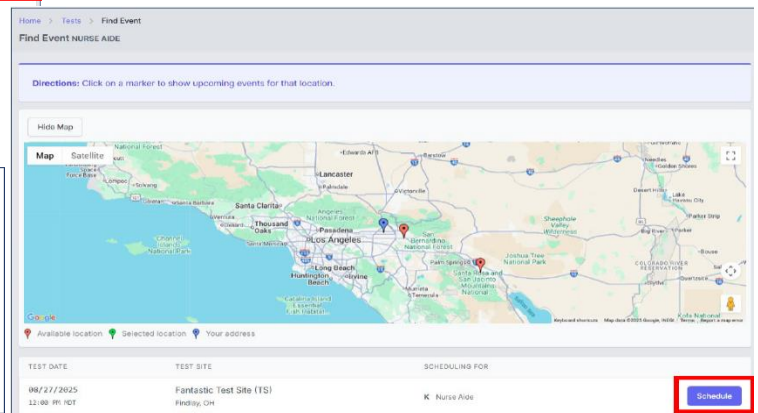
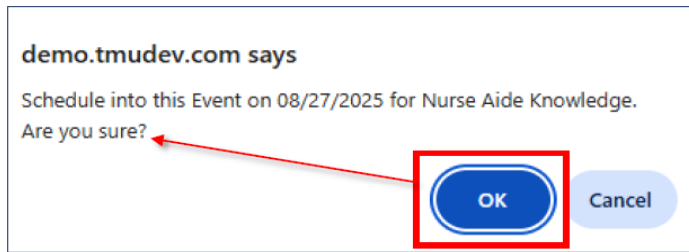


Once your testing fees are paid, you will be eligible to choose a test site and date. Follow the instructions in the next section to schedule or reschedule a test event.

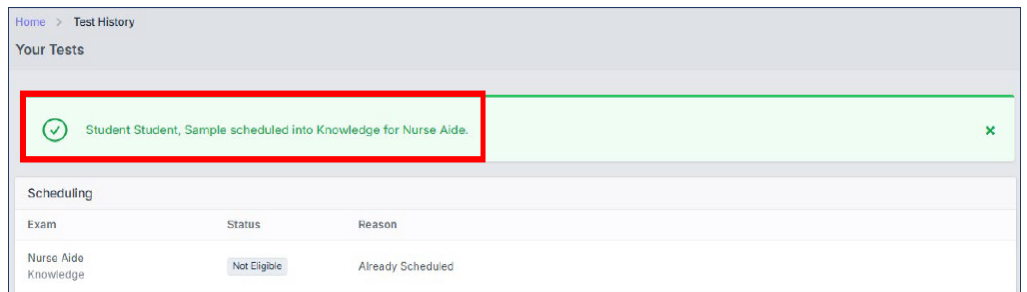
- Schedule your test. Sign in to your TMU account using your Email or User ID and Password. Click Tests to get started. NOTE: Your testing fees must be paid before you can schedule a test.
- You will see which tests you are to schedule for. Click on to the right of the component you are showing eligible to schedule for.



- Follow the directions to select the testing location, date and time to test. Click Schedule.
- You will get a pop up asking you to confirm if you want to schedule into these test events. Click OK to confirm.



- Under Scheduling, you will get a message that you are scheduled. It will show you are not eligible in status because you have already scheduled.



About the test:	Accommodations:	Test Day Checklist	Registry & Maintenance Direct Care Worker (DCW) Registry
<p>Classes or training are not required for testing. Iowa allows testers to challenge the CNA Written and Skills test.</p> <p>1-hour time limit (timer is on the screen), 70 questions, 70% to pass.</p> <p>No calculator allowed. Tester will be given scratch paper and pencil.</p> <p>Retesting/ Tester must wait 7 days to retest the written or skills exam.</p> <p>If 3 failed attempts, you <u>must</u> take 75-hour class again and pass to test for a 4<sup>th</sup> attempt.</p> <p>Tester must PASS both the skills and written within a year of each other.</p>	<p>The tester can select audio reader when self-scheduling the test. (Just check the audio box)</p> <p>All other accommodation must be scheduled through TMU at <a href="https://ia.tmutest.com/apply/7">https://ia.tmutest.com/apply/7</a></p>	<p><b>Valid Government-Issued Photo ID:</b> Must be current.</p> <p><b>Login Credentials:</b> Bring the Username and Password you created during initial setup.</p> <p><b>Completed Setup:</b> Ensure your SS# was added to your profile before arriving</p>	<p><b>Automatic Placement:</b> After passing both exams, your scores are sent to DIAL for placement on the DCW Registry.</p> <p><b>Verification:</b> Approximately one business week after testing, you can verify your status and print your DCW card at <a href="http://dia-hfd.iowa.gov">dia-hfd.iowa.gov</a> using your six-digit ID.</p> <p><b>Work Requirement:</b> Work at least 8 hours in a state-approved long-term care setting every two years.</p> <p><b>Training:</b> Complete 12 hours of in-service training annually if working in a certified facility.</p> <p><b>Expiration:</b> Your registry status expires if you do not work as a CNA for 24 consecutive months.</p>
